Legal Awareness Programme

1. Micro Legal Literacy Projects:

Micro Legal Literacy Camps are being organized by State Authority in the State of Jharkhand at block & panchyat levels, remote villages, hospitals, e.t.c with the cooperation of DLSAs and Sub-DLSCs at District and Taluka level. The Jharkhand State Legal Services Authority has continuously holding the Micro Legal Literacy Camps for both class of the people in small groups including Executive personnel, police Personnel, Judicial Officers and the villagers. In the year 2008, after launching the scheme on Children's day 14th Nov. 2008 and till March 2009 a total number of 384 Micro Legal Literacy Camps held in different Districts of the State of Jharkhand.

REPORT ON ORGANISATION OF “MICRO LEGAL LITERACY CAMPS” IN THE STATE OF JHARKHAND

Pursuant to the direction of National Legal Services Authority, New Delhi regarding organising of “Micro Legal Literacy Camps” under the Micro Legal Literacy Scheme for the year 2008-2009 (Nov-March), a number of Micro Legal Literacy Camps were held in all the 22 districts of the State of Jharkhand at various places specified in the scheme. The Jharkhand State Legal Services Authority itself inaugurated the Micro Legal Literacy Camp at Central School, Hinoo, Ranchi on the occasion of Children's Day on 14th Nov 2008, the report of which is as under:



Jharkhand State Legal Services Authority (JHALSA) conducted the inaugural camp at Kendriya Vidyalaya, Hinoo, Ranchi on the occasion of Children's Day on 14-11-2008. The Camp was inaugurated by paying homage to Late Pd. Jawahar Lal Nehru, by the Hon'ble Executive Chairman, Jharkhand State Legal Services Authority.

A Micro Legal Literacy Camp was organized at the Kendriya Vidyalaya, Hinoo Ranchi on the 14-11-2008 with special emphasis on the rights and duties of Children. The said camp was attended by large number of students from Std 8 to Std 12. The students showed great zeal and enthusiasm in attending the said programme. For imparting special knowledge of our Constitution and the rights of children, a Quiz Contest was organized in the said camp.

The programme was highly successful and created immense curiosity among the children. The students qualifying in the quiz contest were suitably awarded with prizes by the Hon'ble Executive Chairman, Jharkhand State Legal Services Authority, to boost their morale. A special interest in knowing about self rights was seen among the female students and they outnumbered the male candidates in securing prizes.

It is reported that similar programmes have been organized in other districts of Jharkhand at jails, hospitals, melas, festival places, religious places, schools, colleges, labour colonies, market places, pilgrim places, tourist hutments and slums by the respective DLSAs. The District Legal Services Authority conducted Micro Legal



Literacy Camps on the subjects like Protection of Rights of Women and Children, domestic Violence Act, Dowry harassment, property rights, marriage laws, Right to education, Right to employment , Motor accident cases, Government beneficial Schemes, Right to Education, ragging, Protection of Rights of Children against Violence, Basic Laws and Constitutional empowerment, fundamental Rights, Right to information Act, Psycho social issues, Cyber crimes, Labour laws, various forums of dispute resolution, Rights of unorganized labourers, Minimum Wages Act, Workmen compensation Act, Bail provision, free legal services, Prohibition Act, Probation of Offenders Act, Prison Adalat, Execution of sureties, warrants , Nonailable warrants,



right to competent counsel for trial, right and duties, Free Legal services, HIV and trafficking, Registration of births and deaths, Accident cases, Traffic rules and grievances, General laws, Property right, Government beneficial schemes, protection of Rights of Women and children, Dowry prohibition Act, marriage laws, Maintenance, Wards and Guardianship Act, Family dispute counseling , importance of institution of marriage and fundamental rights, fundamental duties and Right to Information Act.
